

NAMEKAGON BARRENS BREAKTHROUGH

The DNR and Burnett County have been negotiating towards an agreement to secure the Namekagon Barrens for over a year. The area involved is owned by Burnett County and has been leased and managed by the DNR for 36 years. The DNR has made a purchase offer and various lease offers. At the most recent Burnett County Forestry Committee a compromise lease was agreed to. We hope that this lease will be approved by the full Burnett County Board.

WSGS members, as well as allies listed elsewhere in this newsletter, worked hard to encourage this action and should be proud of their efforts. Members testified for the Natural Resource Board and the Burnett County Board and dozens of letters and phone calls were sent. Certainly the plight of the barrens community statewide has been raised to a new consciousness level. We need to keep up the educational efforts on this and other areas.

WSGS SPRING MEETING

After last year's freak snow storm on our meeting date we'll try to schedule a better date. This year's spring general membership meeting will be April 24th and 25th at Crex Meadows near Grantsburg. Crex is a great place to visit any time of the year but April is one of the best times. There should be a lot of sharptails as well as migrating waterfowl and other native species.


On Friday evening we'll check in for our evening get together. We'll take up a collection for refreshments. If you wish to bring a stick of sausage or a hunk of cheese or another delicacy I'm sure it would be welcome. We had some great offerings last year. We'll also get organized for the morning surveys.

The Crex dancing ground blinds have been reserved for us for Saturday and Sunday early mornings. There is also the potential to see dancing sharptails on foot or from your car. After breakfast and warming up we'll go back out on Crex again to field tour with Jim Hoefler, the Crex Interpretive Biologist. After a noon meal we will have our meeting. We have invited Minnesota SGS to join us and we hope to have a report from their organization. We would also expect a report on the status of the Moguah transplant and we will have our business meeting.

Saturday afternoon is the end of the formal meeting. You may wish to explore Crex or Fish Lake W.A. or the Namekagon Barrens on your own on Saturday evening and Sunday morning.

The DNR Prairie Grouse Committee will be meeting on Friday, April 24th at Crex preceding our meeting. This meeting will be open to the public so if you come early you may wish to sit in.

You have several choices for housing. The Youth Camp bunkhouses at Crex will be open. These are heated, bare bones accommodations. Bring your sleeping bag if you plan to go this route. The local motel is the Wood River Inn just west of Grantsburg on Highway 70. This is a modern motel with large rooms with adjoining restaurant and indoor pool (\$3.00 charge per person). We have spoken for a block of rooms there. If you intend to go to the motel please make your own reservations as soon as possible and tell them that this is in conjunction with the WSGS. Their number is 715-463-2541 and their rates are 44.26 per double.

Spring Dance at Crex

SHARPTAIL VIEWING SITES

Every spring the sharptails return to traditional dancing grounds for their mating activities. Many of these grounds have long histories of use, while others may be more transient. Wildlife managers and others try to monitor these dancing grounds to keep a handle on populations. Some of these areas have blinds set up for the public to view this fascinating display.

If you do go sharptail watching, plan to be in the blind before daybreak and stay until the birds leave, often three or four hours later. Dress warmly, it's a little less active than ice fishing and about as cold! Bring your camera, tripod if you wish, and binoculars. Medium length telephotos are usually pretty good. Bring a notebook and pencil so you can keep notes that will be useful to the biologists.


The sharptails are active from late March to early May. Some of the more popular sites have a lot of interest and reservation systems. In any event, you should call the manager and find out the local scene. The manager may be able to steer you to a better spot.

If you're really interested in this sport there are always dancing grounds that are not the sure thing, but were active in the past and may be active again. Biologists run out of time to check all their territory. The Michigan Sharptailed Grouse Association has taken on this searching out of uncertain or unknown dancing grounds as a project. It would be good if WSGS could do the same. Again, ask the local manager if you are interested. Wisconsin has a lot of territory in Bayfield, Ashland, Price, Wood, and Jackson Counties among others that should be searched out.

FRIENDS AND ALLIES

The Sharp-tailed Grouse Society is certainly not the only group in Wisconsin that cares about prairie grouse and their habitats. We have a lot of friends, most of whom predate us. We've gained a lot of members from some of these groups. While we certainly want to retain your membership, you may want to consider joining one or more of these groups as well.

The grand daddy groups in prairie grouse management are the Society of Tympanuchus Cupido Pinnatus (STCP) and the Dane County Conservation League (DCCL). These groups started in the mid 50's. Through purchase of lands in central Wisconsin they saved the prairie chicken as part of Wisconsin's wildlife. They continue to be active today in the management of these central Wisconsin grasslands and other projects.

The Wisconsin Society for Ornithology (WSO) is a statewide organization with interest in all birds and their habitats. Grassland birds are of concern to many people within WSO as they continue to see the loss of grassland habitats. WSO

publishes a quarterly report <u>The</u>
<u>Passenger Pigeon</u> of research studies
and bird observations throughout
Wisconsin.

Friends of Crex is just what it sounds like. This organization is made up of people who love Crex Meadows and help out monetarily and in person with management and education efforts at Crex Meadows. Since such a big part of the Crex Meadows story is the upland brush prairie habitat, we obviously have a lot in common.

The Southwest Prairie Enthusiasts (SWPE) is a group based in southwestern Wisconsin but with statewide interests in prairie plants and prairie restoration.

The Nature Conservancy is a national organization with a Wisconsin Chapter. TNC buys and preserves rare habitats. They are known for being able to make deals happen without a lot of red tape. They also publish an excellent magazine that goes to members.
